OPPORTUNITY FOR KIDS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS TO HAVE FUN AND MAKE FRIENDS AS WELL AS BUILD SELF CONFIDENCE AND LEARN LIFE SKILLS. SOME OF THE PROGRAMS INCLUDE FOCUS GROUPS WHICH ARE MADE UP OF 3-4 KIDS WITH SIMILAR SOCIAL SKILL NEEDS, STRUCTURED AND HAVE SPECIFIC SOCIAL SKILL GOALS FOR EACH KID (\$40/HR). PRIVATE RECREATIONAL THERAPY CAN ALSO BE PROVIDED WHICH INCLUDES ASSESSMENT, PROGRAM PLANNING, IMPLEMENTATION AND EVALUATION (\$60/HR). FRIENDSHIP CLUB IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL/HIGH SCHOOL AGE KIDS TO GET INVOLVED ON FRIDAY NIGHTS. THE GOAL IS TO HAVE FUN, MAKE FRIENDS, AND PROVIDE SOCIAL OPPORTUNITIES (USUALLY \$5).
