GAME AND PARKS COMMISSION

Description:

Persons with disabilities can apply for a special permit (apart from their regular permit) to hunt and fish from a vehicle on private land.

Individuals unable, by reason of physical infirmities, to fish without assistance may apply for a special fish permit at a cost of \$8.

Any person who is age 69 or older and a resident of Nebraska may purchase a \$5 small game hunt / fish / fur harvest permit to include all state conservation stamps.

Veterans who are:

age 64 or older may qualify for a \$5 small game hunt / fish / fur harvest permit to include all state conservation stamps.

50% or more disabled, service related, may qualify for a lifetime small game hunt / fish / fur harvest permit to include all state conservation stamps and a lifetime park entry permit.
