MAIN CENTER-1248 SOUTH 10TH STREET, RANGES FROM PRE-SCHOOL CLASSES TO MEETINGS OF NEIGHBORHOOD GROUPS TO AQUATIC PROGRAMS FOR ARTHRITIS PATIENTS, EDUCATION AND RECREATION ACTIVITIES AFTER SCHOOL AND DURING THE SUMMER. INDOOR SWIMMING POOL AND GYM ARE AVAILABLE. FOR OLDER RESIDENTS, FIELD TRIPS, CERAMICS, FRIDAY LUNCH & BINGO, HEALTH MAINTENANCE CHECK-UPS, TAX ASSISTANCE NORTH CENTER-2111 EMMET STREET, AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM FEATURING ARTS, CRAFTS, MUSIC, ATHLETICS, COOKING, DRAMA, RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND FIELD TRIPS, TUTORING PROGRAMS AND A COMPUTER CLASS.
