PROVIDES STATE WIDE AGRABILITY RURAL REHABILITATION PROGRAM THAT SERVES FARM AND RANCH FAMILIES TOUCHED WITH A DISABILITY. IT PROTECT NEBRASKAN'S QUALITY OF LIFE AND PRESERVES THEIR LIVELYHOOD. BY PROVIDING PRACTICAL GUIDANCE AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE, MODIFY FARM EQUIPMENT AND IDENTIFY FUNDING SOURCES.
